

#### FISHER LUTHERAN WELCA SUMMER BIBLE STUDY AFTER CERTAINTY: A BIBLICAL GUIDE

For the people of the Bible, life was often shaped by deep uncertainty. Encounters with God sparked awe, confusion or courage, but rarely certainty. Instead, God's people have always been called to follow God into the unknown, trusting in God's certain grace and love. This three-session summer Bible study explores God's invitation to the people of the Bible and to us, to take the holy journey beyond certainty to curiosity, community and compassion, where we find abundant life in Christ.

#### AFTER CERTAINTY: SESSION 1 - CURIOSITY JUNE 19, 2024 @ 9:00 AM

Jesus' ministry, during the uncertainty of the first century Roman occupation, often challenged the "certainties" of the status quo when it came to faith, power and relationships—both the relationships between people and God, and between people in community.
